



Headteacher blog

The children have had a busy week of learning. New units of inquiry have been introduced and lots of exciting events are being planned for this forthcoming term. Sports day and Year 6 leavers events will hopefully return for all families to enjoy. Keep an eye on the newsletter for regular updates.

We will be holding a Jubilee party for the children on Thursday 26th May. We are asking children and staff to come to school in red, white and blue clothing to enjoy a street party style lunch on the playground, followed by a fun-filled afternoon. The school kitchen will provide a buffet lunch,

similar to when we celebrated the last royal wedding. You may provide your child with a packed lunch if you wish.

Jubilee Mugs – This week children have designed a mug to celebrate the queen's jubilee, Mrs Davies will send details of how to purchase as soon as she is able.
