The promotion of positive behaviours will ensure pupils' rights are met around safety, being heard and learning.

Trerobart's 4 main expectations as stated in our **Behaviour and Positive Relationships** policy are:

- 1. We follow adult instructions.**
- 2. We use words and actions that help and don't hurt.**
- 3. We respect other people and their belongings.**
- 4. We move safely and sensibly around the school.**

Rewards for good behaviour: -

- Praise from Teacher.
- Dojo points.

Sanctions - In line with our Good to be Green behaviour strategy

- Amber warning card
- Red card = timeout (loss of play, time out in class etc) = dojo alert to parent
