### Headteacher's Blog

What a busy week of active learning in Trerobart! It is fantastic to see and hear the children fill the school with such enthusiasm since returning, long may it continue.

Class dojo - Thank you for signing up to classdojo, it enables you to communicate with the class teacher and be a part of your child's learning journey. Lots of learning will be shared on our twitter feed, simply search @trerobart.

**Birthday cakes** – please ensure only individual cakes are brought to school NOT A FULL SIZE CAKE WHICH NEEDS TO BE CUT. Diolch.

**Fruit** – please ensure all fruit for children in foundation phase is either in a named container or has your child's name written on it. It is extremely time consuming for staff to do this, when they should be supporting your child with their learning.

After school clubs – Hapi Club is a lottery funded charity. Hapi Club will be providing a Cooking Club for 16 children in Y5/6 this term. Children who show an interest will be given a consent form and a date for it to be returned. It will be a first come first served basis, children to give their consent to the class teacher at 9am not during breakfast club, to ensure a fair system. If the club is oversubscribed we will create a waiting list.

A sports club will also take place for Y3/4, 32 children are able to attend. This club will involve children participating in a variety of different activities and skills. The signing up process will be the same as above. **Football club for Y4-6**-This club is run by a qualified football coach, Mr Brian Blackmore. He charges £5 a week. This club is on Thursday 3.15pm-4.30pm, money to be given to Brian on the day.

**Gate on Grove Terrace** – This is only for Y Garn families, breakfast club use the far end of the playground so no parents are permitted to come across the playground in the morning.

**Reading Books** – you will notice we have purchased different reading records this year. These records have a section of high frequency and key words to help you and your child practice at home. There are also lots of tips and advice. Please return your book as and when the teacher has requested.

The love of reading is a life skill we want all of Trerobart children to have.
