Literacy Skills

We will be:

- following the Jolly Phonics scheme to learn letter sounds s, a, t, i, p and n.
- experimenting with mark making using a variety of equipment and start tracing over and writing letters, including names.
- Listening and joining in with songs, rhymes and stories.

Show & Tell - each week a different child will bring home a special friend to share with their family and to record the visit in a diary. This develops the children's speaking and listening skills.

<u>How you can help</u>

Encourage your child to be as independent as possible with their toileting needs, dressing themselves, putting coat and shoes on and using cutlery. Support them with recognising and overwriting their name using the correct pencil grip.

When you are out and about look at signs and discuss letters, numbers, shapes and colours, it doesn't have to be about sitting down and learning, make it fun.
