

Literacy Skills

Following Jolly Phonics scheme to learn all our letter sounds and how to write each letter.

Please help your child to practise writing their name/surname regularly.

Show & Tell - each week a different child will bring home a special friend to share with their family and to record the visit in a diary. This develops their speaking and listening skills.

Homework

Homework will be based on either the sound or Maths focus for that week. This will be sent home each Friday and to be returned by the following Thursday in readiness for that week's homework.

During the year the children will be set a small project to complete sometimes as a whole school project.

Home readers will need to be brought to school in their school reading bag EVERYDAY.

High Frequency words will also be sent home every week to learn. Year 1 will be expected to read and write their HFW.



How you can help

Encourage your child to enter the class as independently as possible e.g. Lining up outside before entering class, hanging up their own coat, putting their homework book/bag in the correct box. Also finding their name card when self-registering.

Keep us informed of any changes especially contact details e.g. emergency mobile numbers. medical arrangements etc.

If you ever have any questions please do not hesitate to ask. Dojo is the easiest option especially during the school day and I will try and respond asap.
