Evaluation of Spring Parents Consultation Interviews SCHOOL SELF EVALUATION - March 2017	
Subject: Parent Consultation Interviews	Whole School Involvement
<p><i>How well are we doing? Are we reaching enough parents?</i></p> <p>Last year was the first time we made appointments for parents if they did not return the reply slip. We agreed this is essential to repeat in order to reach even more parents than last year.</p> <p>April 2016: 86% of parents attended with 28% completing a feedback form.</p> <p>March 2017: 82% of parents attended with 73% completing a feedback form</p>

<p>Evidence gathered from monitoring: Through the use of attendance registers and feedback forms.</p> <p>A 4% decrease in attendance from 2016, Y Garn and Pen-y-Fal having the lowest attendance. 45% increase in feedback forms. We ensured as many parents as possible completed the forms before they left the school. Several were returned after the appointment but the majority were completed on the same evening.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Where are we now?</i></p> <p>42 children were not represented at the Spring consultation interview. Two pupils have changed their home situation whilst the others have been encouraged to attend a consultation during the summer term. Providing appointments was successful as feedback made to teachers were in praise of the appointments as they were forgetful returning the slip to school. Feedback showed that parents were pleased with the progress their child was making. They were thankful again for the support the staff at Trerobart show to their child. There was only one negative comment, <i>'the supply teacher only left a few lines of information, not certain reading is at the right level and too many teachers this year, but Trerobart is a good school.'</i> Positive comments include: <i>'We are very pleased with the progress Josh is making. He is very happy and is enjoying the work topics being covered.'</i> <i>'Its reassuring he is working hard'</i> <i>'Mrs Parry was very informative about Kodi's progress'</i> <i>'Helpful, good to contact school using Class DoJo'</i> <i>'Thank you for your time and effort. Honest feedback we only have praise for the teaching he receives.'</i> <i>'He is always talking about how nice the teachers are and is always coming home to show me what he has learnt.'</i></p>
